This Case is coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of Assistant Public Prosecutor for the Complainant, and of Sri **C.Ramesh Natha Reddy**, Advocate for the accused, and upon hearing the arguments on both sides and the matter having stood over for consideration till this day this court delivered the following:-

ORDER

1. The Sub Inspector of Police, Peddapappur Police Station filed charge sheet against the accused No's.1 to 3 in Cr.No.4/2020 of Peddapappur Police Station for the offence U/sec.306 r/w 34 IPC.

2. The brief facts of the case as per the Charge-Sheet are that :

This is disagreed marriage proposal with the deceased A.Nagadevi. The deceased A.Nagadevi studying third year B.Pharmacy in Rami Reddy Pharmacy at Kadapa Town and she fell in love with her relative i.e., Ramakrishna and they decided to get marriage. On 5.1.2020 LW1-A.Peddakatamaiah, LW2-A.Varalakshmi, LW3-P.Gangaraju, LW4-A.Chinna Katamaiah, LW5-P.Ganganna and LW6-K.Kadirappa went to the house of accused. A1 refused to perform marriage with the deceased. Then they returned home and informed the same to her, and then the deceased has shown their relation photos and phone calls details. On

the same day at about 8.00 PM the deceased went to the house of deceased and questioned about the relation between them. A1 to A3 and the parents of accused were agreed to perform marriage and asked 15 tulas gold and 3 cents of house site at Tadipatri town as dowry. Then the accused were agreed at 6 tulas gold and 2 cents of house site at Tadipatri Town. But on 15.1.2020 at about 4.00 PM A1 to A3 were phoned up to LW1 and informed as they will not marry the deceased. On the same day LW1 informed the deceased. On 16.1.2020 at about 3.00 PM LW1-A.Peddakatamaiah, LW2-A.Varalakshmi, LW3-P.Gangaraju, LW4-A.Chinna Katamaiah, LW5-P.Ganganna and LW6-K.Kadirappa went near their house and the deceased was alone in the house, meantime the deceased raised huge cries on hearing of her cries LW1 to 6 went into house and observed that deceased Nagadevi was consumed MARVEX SUPER 100 poison and fell on the ground, then LW1 to 6 were shifted her in Auto to Government Hospital, Tadipatri there the doctors have declared that she is no more. The A1 to A3 were abetting as they will not get marry the deceased Nagadevi and also they instigated that if she will die they get another marriage, due to which she vexed on her life and commit suicide by consuming poison.

Basing on the complaint of LW1-A.Peddakatamaiah, LW14-S.Gouse Mahammed Basha, Sub Inspector of Police, Peddapappur PS registered a case in Cr.No.4/2020 U/s 306 r/w 34 IPC and took up investigation.

LW14-S.Gouse Mahammed Basha, Sub Inspector of Police, Peddapappur PS has left the police station and visited Tadipatri Government Hospital and visited the mortuary room and found the dead body of the deceased A.Nagadevi. Then he left the hospital, visited the scene of offence, secured LW10-C.Yerrinagappa and LW11-M.Sunkanna and seized MARVEX SUPER 100 empty bottle under cover of Mahazarnama and drawn the rough sketch of the scene of offence.

On 17.1.2020 LW14-S.Gouse Mahammed Basha, Sub Inspector of Police, Peddapappur PS has left the police station and visited the Government Hospital, Tadipatri and found the dead body of the deceased and secured the presence of blood relatives of the deceased and inquest panchayatdars and commenced

inquest over the dead body of the deceased. Subsequently, LW14-S.Gouse Mahammed Basha, Sub Inspector of Police, Peddapappur PS has examined LW1 to 6 and recorded their statements.

LW14-S.Gouse Mahammed Basha, Sub Inspector of Police, Peddapappur PS has conducted the inquest and forwarded the dead body for post mortem examination.

On 23.1.2020 LW14-S.Gouse Mahammed Basha, Sub Inspector of Police, Peddapappur PS arrested A1 to A3 and sent for judicial remand.

LW12-Dr.Surya Prakash Reddy, who conducted autopsy over the dead body of the deceased and issued post mortem certificate opining that "The deceased would appear to died due to Organo Phoshate Oral Poisoning".

LW13-Dr.J.Rajasekhar, who has examined the sent material objects and issued report.

3. On perusing the material on hand, cognizance was taken against the accused No's.1 to 3 for the offences U/Sec.306 r/w 34 IPC.

4. On appearing the accused No's.1 to 3, copies of case documents are furnished on the accused No's.1 to 3 as required U/sec.207 of Cr.P.C.

5. Heard the counsel for the accused No's.1 to 3 and perused the record.

6. There is a prima facie case made out against the accused No's.1 to 3 for the offences U/sec.306 r/w 34 IPC which is exclusively triable by the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Ananthapuramu, and hence this case is committed for trial U/sec. 209 (a) of Cr.P.C.

7. The accused No.1 to 3 are obtained bail as per the order dated 5.2.2020 in Crl.M.P.No.27/2020, in Cr.No.4/2020 of Peddapappur Police Station on the file of Hon'ble VI Additional Sessions Judge, Gooty, and they shall be continued on bail until the conclusion of the trial U/sec. 209(b) of Cr.P.C.,

8. The entire record of the case and documents and articles, if any which are to be produced in evidence shall be submitted to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Anantapuramu, U/sec.209(c) of Cr.P.C

9. The Public Prosecutor, Ananthapuramu is notified of committal of this case to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Anantapuramu U/sec.209(d) of Cr.P.C

On questioning the accused No's.1 to 3, they stated that they had means to engage an advocate.
