This petition is coming before me on 09.09.2023 in the presence of Assistant Public Prosecutor for the Prosecution and having being heard and stood over for the consideration this court made the following:

DOCKET ORDER dtd. 09.09.2023

This case is suomotto advanced to today in view of National Lokadalat.

A1 to A6 are present. Copies are furnished to them U/sec.207 Cr.P.C and are examined U/sec.239 Cr.P.C for offences punishable U/secs.379 IPC and sec.21(1) of MMDR act. Charges for offences punishable U/sec.379 IPC and Sec.21(1) of MMDR Act is read over and explained to A1 to A6 in their vernacular language for which the A1 to A6 pleaded guilty voluntarily for offences U/sec.379 IPC and Sec.21(1) of MMDR act.

The plea appears to this Court to be voluntary. Hence, the same is accepted, and A1 to A6 are found guilty and are convicted U/sec.241 Cr.P.C for offences punishable U/secs.379 IPC and sec.21(1) of MMDR Act. A1 to A6 submitted nothing when questioned on quantum of sentence.

In the result, in view of National Lokadalat, A1 to A6 are directed to pay a fine of Rs.500/- each for offence punishable U/sec.379 IPC. A1 to A6 are further directed to pay a fine of Rs.500/- each for offence punishable U/sec.21(1) of MMDR Act. Total fine amount of Rs.6,000/- shall be paid by A1 to A6. In default of which, they shall be suffer simple imprisonment for seven days. The bail bonds and surety bonds of A1 to A6 shall stand cancelled on expiry of appeal period. Since no seized property deposited before this Court, there is no order as to property.

Pursuant to oral instructions received from higher authorities in view of National Lok-Adalat, this matter is settled accordingly.
