ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

1) Today perused the complaint and the documentary evidences. Upon perusal of the documentary evidences, the cheque in question is not within the territorial jurisdiction of this court. As per the well known latest reported judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme court of India, in case of Dashrath Rupsingh Rathod v/s. State of Maharashtra, Criminal Appeal No. 2287/09, 1593-1604/14 decided on 01/08/2014, the complainant has to file the complaint, at the place from which the cheque in question is dishonored. Hence, this court has now no territorial jurisdiction to try and entertain the present complaint.

2) Under the circumstances, the following order is passed in the interest of justice :

ORDER

The present complaint and all the original documents produced with the complaint, if any, is hereby ordered to be returned back to the complainant, to present the same before an appropriate court, having territorial jurisdiction.
