Today stands fixed for hearing of the petition u/s. 12 of Guardians and Wards Act, 1890.

Petitioner is present by filing hazira.

One petition is filed by the OP praying for time for filing W.O on the ground stated therein.

On call none appears on behalf of the OP to move the petition. Hence, prayer for time is considered but rejected.

Now the petition u/s.12 of Guardians and Wards Act is taken up for hearing on ex parte basis.

In present petition the applicant being father, a natural guardian of the minor named Parishmita Sarkar, now aged about 06 years who is presently staying in custody of the opposite party no.2 / mother, residing at her maternal home, has sought for visiting his said daughter at any befitting place and time as the Court thinks fit and proper.

Having heard Ld. Advocate for the petitioner and on consideration of instant petition the same seeking visitation of minor child by her farther-petitioner is accepted subject to following conditions :-

1. The parties are at liberty to cause meeting of the child on 1st Saturday of every month from 05:00 pm to 07:00 pm (two hours) at Shiv Jyoti Bhawan, Trishulapatti, Prajapati Brahma Kumaris Ishwariya Vishwavidyalay, Bolpur in presence of Sister Priti (in-charge) (contact no.8759204940) or any other representative of Sister Priti.
2. The opposite party no.2 will bring the child named Parishmita Sarkar at the above sacred place at 05:00 pm to 07:00 pm to allow meeting with her father i.e. applicant in their presence.
3. Custody of the child must not be temporarily transferred.

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4. It will be open to the parties to have slight modification in this arrangement, if situation so warrants, provided the parties are agreeable to such arrangement.

While allowing the right of visitation of the father / applicant the moral and ethical welfare of the child and his interest is kept on top consideration. I have handled the matter with utmost care and caution and also applied love, affection and sentiments for giving human touch to the problem.

Hence, it is

ORDERED

That instant petition dated 13.11.2024 for visitation of father applicant to his natural daughter is allowed in the light of the conditions set up in foregoing paragraphs till further order.

Petitioner Partha Sarkar is directed to appear personally before Shiv Jyoti Bhawan, Trishulapatti, Prajapati Brahma Kumaris Ishwariya Vishwavidyalay, Bolpur on the date of visitation with his minor child.

Copy of order be supplied to the petitioner free of cost.

Another copy of order be sent to the Sister Priti, in-charge of Shiv Jyoti Bhawan, Trishulapatti, Prajapati Brahma Kumaris Ishwariya Vishwavidyalay, Bolpur for information and taking necessary action.

Fixing **17.07.2025** for final hearing of this case.
