The case is fixed for arguments on two applications i.e. one for dismissal of execution petition moved on behalf of judgment debtors no. 2 and 3 and another for issuing warrant of arrest of JDs namely Shri Amar Agarwal and Ms. Uma Aggarwal moved on behalf of DH. Learned counsel appearing for judgments debtors no.2 and 3 has informed that draft affidavit has been forwarded to the judgment debtors for signing the same and once the same is received back she would tender the same on the court file. The draft affidavit was shown to the court according to which the properties of the judgment debtors are situated in West Bengal. Learned counsel for DH has stated that he will also seek instruction from his client regarding the manner in which to proceed further with the present execution petition after filing affidavit on behalf of judgment debtors no.2 and 3.

So, the case is adjourned to **12.08.2025** for tendering affidavit under Order XXI Rule 41 CPC on behalf of JDs no.2 and 3. Arguments on aforesaid applications will also be heard, if need arises.
