Order No. 03 dated 17.03.2026

The application u/s 482 of BNSS is moved by the Ld. Advocate praying for anticipatory bail of the petitioners, namely, (1) Balaram Ghosh, (2) Uttam Mondal, (3) Benimadhab Mondal, (4) Abhijit Mondal, (5) Nilay Mondal, (6) Purna Chandra Mondal, (7) Ranjit Bauri and (8) Arun Kumar Mondal in connection with Dubrajpur P.S. Case No.411 of 2025 dated 11.11.2025 u/s 79/ 329(3)/ 324(4)(5)/ 115(2)/ 117(2)/ 118(2)/ 109/ 3(5) of BNS, giving rise to G.R. Case No.785 of 2025 of the Court of Ld. Judicial Magistrate, Dubrajpur, Birbhum.

An affidavit has been filed by Balaram Ghosh, one of the petitioners of this case stating that no such bail application under section 482 of BNSS has been filed, nor any application is rejected by any higher forum.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case and if the petitioners are released on bail, they will not abscond and will cooperate with the IO for the purpose of investigation. He further submits that no incident ever took place to bring the offence under the purview of the alleged Sections mentioned in the FIR. He also submits that co-accused is on bail. On above plea, Ld. Advocate for the petitioners prays for admission of the petitioners on anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions.

Ld. PP, Birbhum has raised objection and produced the CD for my perusal.

I have heard both sides.

Perused the C.D and also the T.C.R.

It appears that investigation of this case is in progress. Medical report suggests that there is sufficient material to attract the ingredient the Section 109 of BNS. Possibility of involvement of the present petitioners cannot be ruled out. In such circumstances, if the benefit of section 482 of BNSS is extended to the petitioners then there is every possibility that it will hamper the investigation of this process. Thus, the nature of offence deserves custodial interrogation of the petitioners. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioners stands **rejected**.
