The application u/s 482 of BNSS is moved by the Ld. Advocate praying for anticipatory bail of the petitioners, namely, (1) Enamul Hossain @ Enamul Sekh and (2) Mahi Sk @ Mahiuddin Sekh in connection with Nalhati P.S. Case No.248 of 2025 dated 23.05.2025 u/s 126(2)/ 115(2)/ 117(2)/ 118(2)/ 109(1)/ 74/ 351(2)/ 3(5) of BNS, giving rise to G.R. Case No.1225 of 2025 of the Court of Ld. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rampurhat, Birbhum.

An affidavit has been filed by Enamul Hossain @ Enamul Sekh, one of the petitioners of this case stating that no such bail application under section 482 of BNSS has been filed, nor any application is rejected by any higher forum.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case and if the petitioners are released on bail, they will not abscond and will face the trial. Ld. Lawyer for the petitioners further submits that the alleged Sections are inserted in the FIR is an abuse of process of law. He also submits that charge sheet has already been submitted. It is his submission that other co-accused is on bail. On above plea, Ld. Advocate for the petitioners prays for admission of the petitioners on anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions as the Court thinks fit and proper.

Ld. PP-in-charge, Birbhum has raised objection and produced the CD for my perusal.

I have heard both sides.

Perused the C.D and also the T.C.R.

It appears from the record that charge sheet has already been submitted in the year 2025 thereby leaving no scope of custodial interrogation anymore. It reveals from the record that other co-accused is already on bail. Considering the fact of submission of charge sheet, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

Hence, it is,

Ordered

that in the event of arrest, petitioners, namely, (1) Enamul Hossain @ Enamul

Sekh and (2) Mahi Sk @ Mahiuddin Sekh, may be released on bail of Rs.3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs.1500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer of this case on condition that the petitioners shall abide by the provision as laid down in section 482(2) of BNSS.

Let a copy of this order along with the T.C.R. of G.R. Case No.1225 of 2025 be sent to the Ld. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rampurhat, Birbhum for information and taking necessary action.

Let another copy of this order be sent to the S.P, Birbhum for information.
