The case record is put up today by way of a put up petition.

The put up petition is considered and allowed.

Ld. P.P in-charge is present.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person is also present.

Now, the petition praying for pleading guilty filed by the accused person namely Santanu Mondal is taken up for hearing.

Heard both sides.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused person submits that at this stage the accused person does not want to contest with the case as he has been suffering much about this case due to his economic condition. Now, he wants to dispose of the matter by way of pleading his guilt.

Ld. P.P in-charge and Ld. Lawyer for the WBSSEDCL do not oppose the prayer of the guilt of the accused.

In course of hearing, the accused person is orally examined by the court who has stated that he was fully aware about the charge brought against him and pleads guilty by saying that "*Ami Dosh Korechhe.*"

After hearing it appears to me that his plea of guilt is clear and unambiguous and the same is free from any undue influence and coercion. Accordingly, the plea of guilt made by accused person is accepted and he is convicted for the offence punishable under Section 135(1)(b) of the Electricity Act, 2003.

Hence it is,

ORDERED

that the accused person, namely, Santanu Mondal is found guilty for the offence under Section 135(1)(b) of the Electricity Act and convicted.

On being asked convict, Santanu Mondal states that he is poor person. He prays for mercy and lessor punishment due to his poor economic condition.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as his poor economic condition, I am of the view that the fine of Rs.5,700/- would be appropriate and justified for the convict, Santanu Mondal.

Accordingly the convict, Santanu Mondal is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.5,700/- i.d, simple imprisonment for six days.

The above accused person Santanu Mondal is released from his bail bond.

The seized articles which were given to the complainant on zimmanama be made absolute as per law.

The case is disposed of.

The record need not put up on 04.05.26.
