The application u/s 482 of BNSS is moved by the Ld. Advocate praying for anticipatory bail of the petitioners, namely, (1) Sk Jakir Hossain @ Sk Jakir and (2) Sk Najir Hossain @ Sk Najiruddin in connection with Sadaipur P.S. Case No.42 of 2026 dated 13.03.2026 u/s 329(4)/ 118(1)/ 117(2)/ 109/ 3(5) of BNS, giving rise to G.R. Case No.411 of 2026 of the Court of Ld. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Suri, Birbhum.

An affidavit has been filed by Sk Najir Hossain @ Sk Najiruddin, one of the petitioners of this case stating that no such bail application under section 482 of BNSS has been filed, nor any application is rejected by any higher forum.

It is submitted by Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that over a construction dispute both parties had a verbal altercation which was followed by jostling. The alleged injured did not receive any serious injury as the bodily injury which he has received is self-inflicted one. Pleading false implication and undertaking to cooperate with investigation, if admitted on anticipatory bail, Ld. Advocate for the petitioners prays for admission of the petitioners on anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions as the Court thinks fit and proper.

Ld. PP-in-charge, Birbhum has raised usual objection after referring my attention on the injury report on page no.28 – 33. He furnishes the CD and prays for passing necessary order.

I have heard both sides.

Perused the C.D especially the injury report and also the T.C.R.

In view of the background of incident and also considering simple nature of injury opined on page no.30 by the medical expert the petitioners are admitted on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

Hence,

O r d e r e d

that in the event of arrest, petitioners, namely, (1) Sk Jakir Hossain @ Sk Jakir and (2) Sk Najir Hossain @ Sk Najiruddin, may be released on bail of Rs.3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs.1500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer of this case on condition that the petitioners shall abide by the provision as laid down in section 482(2) of BNSS.

Let a copy of this order along with the T.C.R. of G.R. Case No.411 of 2026 be sent to the Ld. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Suri, Birbhum for information and taking necessary action.
