The application u/s 482 of BNSS is moved by the Ld. Advocate praying for anticipatory bail of the petitioners, namely, (1) Sakshi Mondal @ Dighar @ Sakshigopal Mondal, (2) Joga Mondal @ Jagananath Mondal and (3) Bhadu Mondal @ Mondal Ananda in connection with Nanoor P.S. Case No.42 of 2026 dated 17.03.2026 u/s 126(2)/ 115(2)/ 109(1)/ 76/ 351(3)/ 3(5) of BNS, giving rise to G.R. Case No.326 of 2026 of the Court of Ld. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bolpur, Birbhum.

An affidavit has been filed by Sakshi Mondal @ Dighar @ Sakshigopal Mondal, one of the petitioners of this case stating that no such bail application under section 482 of BNSS has been filed, nor any application is rejected by any higher forum.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners submits that over a neighbourhood dispute both parties had a verbal altercation. No incident of any physical assault ever took place. He further submits that the instant case is started under provision of section 175(3) of BNSS after preferring a complaint before this Court on 30.01.2026 which is after 26 days from the alleged incident. Citing instant FIR as concocted and afterthought, Ld. Advocate for the petitioners prays for admission of the petitioners on anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions as the Court thinks fit and proper. He also undertakes to cooperate with investigation, if admitted on anticipatory bail.

Ld. PP-in-charge, Birbhum has raised usual objection. He furnishes the CD for my perusal drawing my notice on statement of the victim lady on page no.35 u/s. 183 of BNSS and other statements of witnesses recorded thereon. He also takes my notice to the injury report on page no.23 – 25.

I have heard both sides.

Perused the C.D and also the T.C.R.

In view of the judicial statement of the victim lady on page no.35 and also considering the nature of injury which is not opined to be serious there appears no good reason to ask the petitioners to face custodial interrogation. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

Hence,

O r d e r e d

that in the event of arrest, petitioners, namely, (1) Sakshi Mondal @ Dighar @ Sakshigopal Mondal, (2) Joga Mondal @ Jagananath Mondal and (3) Bhadu Mondal @ Mondal Ananda, may be released on bail of Rs.3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs.1500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer of this case on

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condition that the petitioners shall abide by the provision as laid down in section 482(2) of BNSS.

Let a copy of this order along with the T.C.R. of G.R. Case No.326 of 2026 be sent to the Ld. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bolpur, Birbhum for information and taking necessary action.

Let another copy of this order be sent to the S.P, Birbhum for information.

CD be returned.

The Cr. Misc. Case is disposed of.
