Today is fixed for further cross examination of PW-1.

The sole accused person namely Saiful Alam is produced from J.C. He is remanded to J.C till date. (i.e. on 05.07.2023).

PW-1 Sourav Pal is present. His cross examination is resumed today and is continued till 01:15PM. Since the Court is busy with other judicial as well as administrative works, the case is adjourned.

Fix 05.07.2023 for further cross examination of the PW-1.

Since there is direction of Hon'ble Court in this regard for completion of trial, I am of opinion that consecutive date is to be fixed for completion of trial. At this juncture, Ld. Advocate for both parties submitted that fixing of three dates for examination of CSW-2 in stead of all witnesses as the case is based on documentary evidence. Having regard to their submission, fix 06.07.2023, 28.07.2023 & 29.07.2023 for examination of CSW-2. (the date has been fixed in open Ejlash after making consultation of the Advocates appearing on behalf of the parties which is convenient to them).

Bail petition is filed on behalf of the accused praying for releasing him on bail since the accused is in custody for a considerable period and there is a direction from Hon'ble Court for completion of trial within one year but that order has not been carried out and accordingly prays for passing necessity order.

On perusal of the order, I find that on several occasions bail prayer of the accused was rejected by the Hon'ble Court Calcutta under Section 439 Cr.P.C.

Fact remains that the evidence of prosecution started on 27.04.2022.

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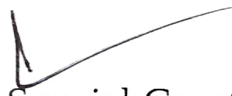
Prosecution has taken three days for completion of chief examination whereas lengthy cross examination is going on, on behalf of the accused, which were held on different dates commencing from 22.11.2022 and continued till date. In such circumstances and considering the gravity of the case, I am of opinion that this is not fit case where the accused be enlarged on bail and accordingly, prayer for bail stands **rejected**.

Both parties are however requested not to take unnecessary adjournment and to complete the trial as directed by Hon'ble Court as soon as possible.
