The record is put up today by way of a put up petition.

Ld. P.P in-charge is present.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person is also present.

Now, the petition praying for pleading guilty filed by the accused person namely Fatema Bibi is taken up for hearing.

Heard both sides.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused person submits that at this stage the accused person does not want to contest with the case as she has been suffering much about this case due to her economic condition. Now, she wants to dispose of the matter by way of pleading her guilt.

Ld. P.P in-charge and Ld. Lawyer for the WBSEDCL do not oppose the prayer of the guilt of the accused.

In course of hearing, the accused person is orally examined by the court who has stated that she was fully aware about the charge brought against her and plead guilty by saying that "*Ami Dosh Korechhe.*"

After hearing it appears to me that her plea of guilt is clear and unambiguous and the same is free from any undue influence and coercion. Accordingly, the plea of guilt made by accused person is accepted and she is convicted for the offence punishable under Section 135(1) (a) & (b) of the Electricity Act, 2003.

Hence it is,

ORDERED

that the accused person, namely, Fatema Bibi is found guilty for the offence under Section 135(1) (a) & (b) of the Electricity Act and convicted.

On being asked convict, Fatema Bibi states that she is poor person. She prays for mercy and lessor punishment due to her poor economic condition.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as her poor economic condition, I am of the view that the fine of Rs.2,000/- would be appropriate and justified for the convict, Fatema Bibi.

Accordingly the convict, Fatema Bibi is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.2,000/-, i.d, simple imprisonment for two days.

The above accused person Fatema Bibi is released from her bail bond.

The surety of the above accused person, Fatema Bibi also be discharged from her liability of the bail bond.

The case is thus disposed of.
