Ld.Advocate for the claimants/petitioners submits before this tribunal that this case was filed by the claimants/petitioners u/s 166 of M.V.Act but now the claimants/petitioners are willing to proceed with the case u/s 164 of M.V. Act and thus, the Ld.Advocate for the claimants/petitioners prays for amendment from section 166 of MV Act to u/s 164 of M.V.Act.
