This petition is coming on for hearing before me on 12/01/2026
and on the same day the court passed the following:

JUDGMENT

Petition filed U/s. 7(1)(b) of the Family Courts Act.

2. Petition for declaration of marital status of the petitioners.
3. The petitioners are husband and wife and they belong to Muslim religion. Their marriage was solemnized on 20.04.2015 at Mangalya Auditorium, Kottiyam as per the Muslim religious rites and ceremonies. After marriage the petitioners were residing together as husband and wife. Due to difference of opinion the petitioners have been living separately. In spite of earnest efforts made by their relatives and friends, they could not restore the martial relationship. The marriage between them has been irretrievably broken and there is no chance for re-union. Finally the petitioners agreed to dissolve their marriage

and executed Mubarath agreement on 13.07.2017. The entire financial claims between the petitioners have been settled and there is no claim or liability to be settled between the parties and there is no collusion in filing this petition. Hence the marital status of the petitioners is to be declared.

4. Petitioners filed separate affidavits and their statements were recorded. The Marriage Certificate is marked as Ext. A1 and Mubarath agreement is marked as Ext. A2.

5. Heard the petitioners and perused the records.

6. It is evident from Ext. A2 that the marriage between the petitioners was dissolved as per extra judicial divorce and that all the claims between the petitioners were settled. So the petitioners are entitled to get decree for declaration of marital status.

In the result, the original petition is allowed. It is hereby declared that the marriage solemnized between the petitioners on 20.04.2015 is dissolved by the Mubarath agreement dated 13.07.2017 and that they are no more husband and wife with effect from the date of Mubarath agreement. No costs.
