Today is fixed for appearance and further cross-examination of PW-4. PW-4 is not present today. One witness, namely, Mrinal Kanti Pal is examined in full as PW-5 and his cross-examination is declined by the defence. No other prosecution witness is present.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused person and Ld. Special P.P. in-charge are present. Heard both sides. Perused the case record.

It appears that charge against the accused person was framed on 22.12.2020 u/s 18 of NDPS Act. The first date for evidence of prosecution witness was fixed on 12.03.2021. Thereafter, several dates were fixed for evidence of prosecution witnesses. Prosecution has till now examined five witnesses in spite of giving sufficient opportunities to adduce evidence within a period of almost 5 years.

As per provisions of Case Flow Management Rules, 2006 framed by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, the cases under the provision of NDPS Act should be placed in Track-I and endeavour should be made to complete the case within 9 months from the date of framing charge.

Considering the age of this case and the opportunities given to the prosecution to adduce evidence and in compliance of the provisions of Case Flow Management Rules, 2006 framed by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, I am of the opinion that the evidence on the side of prosecution should be closed and accordingly the evidence of prosecution is closed.
