The application u/s 482 of BNSS is moved by the Ld. Advocate praying for anticipatory bail of the petitioner, namely, Jalal @ Samsuddin Sekh, in connection with Dubrajpur PS case No.136 of 2026 dated 20.04.2026 u/s 126(2)/ 132/ 221/ 109(1)/ 121(2)/ 303(2)/ 317(2)/ 317(3)/ 317(4)/ 317(5)/ 351(2)/ 3(5) of BNS, giving rise to G.R Case No.261 of 2026 of the Court of Ld. Judicial Magistrate, Dubrajpur, Birbhum.

An affidavit has been filed by Jalal @ Samsuddin Sekh, the petitioner himself of this case stating that no such bail application under section 482 of BNSS has been filed, nor any application is rejected by any higher forum.

The Ld. advocate for the petitioner has submitted that though the petitioner is not named in the FIR, there is information that police may arrest him in connection with this case for which the petitioner has come before the Court with a prayer for pre-arrest bail. On above plea, Ld. Advocate for the petitioners prays for admission of the petitioners on anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions.

Ld. PP-in-charge, Birbhum has raised objection and produced the CD.

Both sides have been heard.

Perused the C.D. and the T.C.R.

The defacto complainant lodged the complaint to the effect that DSP, Crime on 20.04.2026 at about 07:00am detained a sand loaded tractor and then called the O/C Dubrajpur to guard the tractor. Thereafter DSP, Crime left the place and then the accused along with other people physically assaulted the defacto complainant with an intention to kill him.

Considering the nature and gravity of the alleged offence, prayer for anticipatory bail in respect of the petitioner stands **rejected**.

Let a copy of this order along with the T.C.R. of G.R case no. 261 of 2026 be sent to the Ld. Judicial Magistrate, Dubrajpur, Birbhum for information and taking necessary action.
