The application u/s 482 of BNSS is moved by the Ld. Advocate praying for anticipatory bail of the petitioners, namely, (1) Piku Das @ Biplab Das, (2) Narayan Das, (3) Samar Mukherjee @ Samar Kumar Mukherjee, (4) Prasanjit Saha @ Prasenjit Saha and (5) Radha Kanta Banerjee in connection with Panrui P.S. Case No.67 of 2026 dated 22.05.2026 u/s 448/ 427/ 329/ 323/ 325/ 307/ 506/ 34 of IPC, giving rise to G.R. Case No.803 of 2026 of the Court of Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Suri, Birbhum.

An affidavit has been filed by Radha Kanta Banerjee, one of the petitioners of this case stating that no such bail application under section 482 of BNSS has been filed, nor any application is rejected by any higher forum.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case and if the petitioners are released on bail they will not abscond and will co-operate with the investigation. Ld. Lawyer for the petitioners further submits that no incident ever took place to bring the offence under the purview of Section 307 of IPC. On above plea, Ld. Advocate for the petitioners prays for admission of the petitioners on anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions as the Court thinks fit and proper.

Ld. PP-in-charge, Birbhum has raised objection and produced the CD for my perusal.

I have heard both sides.

Perused the C.D and also the T.C.R.

There is no injury report collected by the IO till 17.06.2026. There is no material suggesting likelihood of absconding or tampering with evidence. Considering the above facts and circumstances, I am of the view that the custodial interrogation of the accused persons are not required. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

Hence, it is,

Ordered

that in the event of arrest, petitioners, namely, (1) Piku Das @ Biplab Das, (2) Narayan Das, (3) Samar Mukherjee @ Samar Kumar Mukherjee, (4) Prasanjit Saha @ Prasenjit Saha and (5) Radha Kanta Banerjee, may be released on bail of Rs.4,000/- each with two sureties of Rs.2000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer of this case on condition that the petitioners shall abide by the provision as laid down in section 482(2) of BNSS.
