Order No. 03 dated 10.06.2026

The application u/s 482 of BNSS is moved by the Ld. advocate praying for anticipatory bail of the petitioners, namely, (1) Ganesh Mondal, (2) Koushik Mondal and (3) Tapati Mondal in connection with Sainthia P.S. Case No.170 of 2026 dated 16.05.2026 u/s 126(2)/ 115(2)/ 117(2)/ 118(2)/ 351(3)/ 3(5) of BNS, giving rise to G.R. Case No.754 of 2026 of the Court of Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Suri, Birbhum.

An affidavit has been filed by Ganesh Mondal, one of the petitioners of this case stating that no such bail application under section 482 of BNSS has been filed, nor any application is rejected by any higher forum.

The Ld. advocate for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners belong to the same family and they have not committed any offence as alleged. The Ld. advocate has argued that no grievous hurt has been inflicted upon the victim and therefore, at this stage the petitioners may be granted anticipatory bail as there is no chance of running away or tampering with evidence.

Ld. PP-in-charge, Birbhum has raised objection by referring to the materials in the CD which indicates that petitioners are not completely innocent and one Shibu Das was assaulted by them.

Both sides have been heard.

Perused the C.D and also the T.C.R.

Having perused the CD and having heard both sides it is found that at this stage granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner no.01 will not be appropriate and hence, the prayer stands **refused**. However, in view of the nature of allegations against other two petitioners, it is opined that they may be given the liberty and the same will not create any impediment in the process of investigation. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed** in respect of petitioners no.02 & 03.

Hence, it is,

Ordered

that in the event of arrest, petitioners, namely, (2) Koushik Mondal and (3) Tapati Mondal, may be released on bail of Rs.4,000/- each with one surety of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer of this case on condition that the petitioners shall abide by the provision as laid down in section 482(2) of BNSS with condition that the male petitioner no.02 will meet the IO once a week till completion of investigation.
