Order No. 03 dated 09.07.2026

The application u/s 482 of BNSS is moved by the Ld. Advocate praying for anticipatory bail of the petitioners, namely, (1) Mamata Das Bairagya and (2) Kabita Bagdi @ Kabita (Mal) Mete in connection with Kirmahar P.S. Case No.10 of 2026 dated 09.02.2026 u/s 126(2)/ 103(1)/ 3(5) of BNS, giving rise to G.R. Case No.149 of 2026 of the Court of Ld. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bolpur, Birbhum.

An affidavit has been filed by (1) Mamata Das Bairagya and (2) Kabita Bagdi @ Kabita (Mal) Mete, petitioners of this case stating that no such bail application under section 482 of BNSS has been filed, nor any application is rejected by any higher forum.

The Ld. Advocate for the petitioners has submitted that the main accused are in custody and investigation has culminated in charge sheet for which there will be no need for any detention of the accused persons. It is pointed out that the petitioners are both women and therefore, it will not be necessary to take them in custody for the purpose of further prosecution of the case.

The defacto complainant has entered appearance by engaging an advocate. Ld. advocate for the defacto complainant has raised objection by submitting that all the petitioners have jointly killed the deceased by brutally assaulting him.

Ld. PP, Birbhum while opposing the bail prayer has asserted that all the charge sheeted accused persons were involved behind the murder and the petitioners have been running away to avoid the process of law. It is submitted that the bail prayer made at this stage is liable to be rejected.

All sides have been heard.

Perused the C.D and also the T.C.R.

In this case, under section 103(1) of BNS, charge sheet has been filed which implicates that prima facie guilt has been established. The petitioners may be women but they were avoiding the process of law and at this stage this Court is not in favour of granting bail after considering the materials in the CD. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail under section 482 is **rejected**.

Let a copy of this order along with the T.C.R. of G.R. Case No.149 of 2026 be sent to the Ld. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bolpur, Birbhum for information and taking necessary action.
