The application u/s 482 of BNSS is moved by the Ld. Advocate praying for anticipatory bail of the petitioners, namely, (1) Sekh Iroz, (2) Md. Akram Molla, (4) Taijul Molla, (5) Paban Majhi, (6) Somnath Saren, (7) Rabinath Mardi and (8) Raban Mardi in connection with Bolpur P.S. Case No.215 of 2026 dated 02.06.2026 u/s 341/ 323/ 325/ 506/ 379/ 34 of IPC, giving rise to G.R. Case No.695 of 2026 of the Court of Ld. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bolpur, Birbhum.

An affidavit has been filed by Raban Mardi, one of the petitioners of this case stating that no such bail application under section 482 of BNSS has been filed, nor any application is rejected by any higher forum.

The Ld. advocate for the petitioners has submitted that FIR is an aftermath of post poll violence after 2021 general election and the allegations are false and fabricated. Submitting that the case has been initiated in order to harass the political rivals, the Ld. advocate has pleaded for pre-arrest bail of the petitioners. It is further submitted that the petitioners will cooperate with the IO and shall not run away.

Ld. PP, Birbhum has raised objection and produced the CD for perusal.

Both sides have been heard.

Perused the C.D and also the T.C.R.

Having scrutinized statements of witnesses and other materials it is found that at this stage of investigation if the prayer is considered then hardly any prejudice would occur to the process of investigation. The accused are the permanent residents of the area and therefore, the prayer may be allowed. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed** in respect of petitioners no.01, 02, 04, 05, 06, 07 & 08.

Hence, it is,

Ordered

that in the event of arrest, petitioners, namely, (1) Sekh Iroz, (2) Md. Akram Molla, (4) Taijul Molla, (5) Paban Majhi, (6) Somnath Saren, (7) Rabinath Mardi and (8) Raban Mardi, may be released on bail of Rs.2,000/- each with one surety of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer of this case on condition that the petitioners shall abide by the provision as laid down in section 482(2) of BNSS with condition to meet the IO once in 20th July, 2026 and thereafter, once a month till completion of investigation.
