Sentence/Order : Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of ₹.1,000/- For the offence
U/s 118(a) of K.P Act. In default of payment of fine he shall
undergo simple imprisonment for 1 day.

This case having been heard finally on this day the court delivered the following:

JUDGMENT

The Sub Inspector of police, has filed a charge sheet against the accused alleging offences punishable U/s 118(a) of K.P Act.

2. The prosecution case is that the accused was found in a public place in an intoxicated manner and incapable of looking after himself. The accused has thereby committed the above said offence.

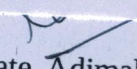
3. Pursuant to the filing of final report cognizance was taken for the offence U/s 118(a) of K.P Act. On receipt of process the accused appeared before this court, copies of relevant records were furnished to him. A charge was framed U/s 118(a) of K.P Act and read over to the accused to which he pleaded guilty. I am satisfied that the plea made by the accused is voluntarily and without any compulsion. Hence the accused is convicted for the offence punishable u/s 118(a) of K.P. Act.

4. Heard on sentences Accused prayed for leniency.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of the offence I am of the view and that no jail term is required to be imposed on the accused. Mere imposition of fine will serve the purpose sentencing in this case.

In the result, the accused is sentenced to pay a fine of ₹. 1,000/- For the offence u/s 118(a) of K.P Act. In default of payment of fine he shall undergo simple imprisonment for 1 day.
