From the record, it appears that the Ld. Arbitrator passed the award on 18.03.2022 giving the judgement debtor to pay the amount as mentioned in the award. Due to non-payment of the amount the decree holder files an Execution case.

As per direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in connection with Civil Appeal No. 3640-3642 of 2025 (arising out of SLP © Nos. 8490-8492 of 2020) in the matter of PERIYAMMAL (DEAD) through LRS & ORS. VS V. Rajamani & Anr. Etc., the Hon'ble Court has been pleased to give direction to all the High Courts across the country for giving direction to all District Judiciary to ensure the execution petition pending in various Courts shall be decided and disposed of within a period of six months without fail otherwise the concerned presiding officer would be answerable to the High Court on its Administrative Side.

From the record, it appears that the judgement debtor initially entered appearance in this case but subsequently they did not turn up so O.C., Khairasole P.S is directed to secure the attendance of the judgement debtor by 11.08.2026.
