The application u/s 482 of BNSS is moved by the Ld. advocate praying for anticipatory bail of the petitioner, namely, Prasanta Kumar Sadhu @ Jhokon Kr. Sadhu @ Sadhu Prashanta, in connection with Sainthia PS case No.215 of 2026 dated 12.06.2026 u/s 316(5)/ 318(4)/ 314/ 61(2) of BNS, giving rise to G.R Case No.977 of 2026 of the Court of Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Suri, Birbhum.

An affidavit has been filed by Prasanta Kumar Sadhu @ Jhokon Kr. Sadhu @ Sadhu Prashanta, the petitioner himself of this case stating that no such bail application under section 482 of BNSS has been filed, nor any application is rejected by any higher forum.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner has submitted that the FIR is concocted and it is made without any material basis. The Ld. advocate has contended that no seizure has been made from his possession. Submitting that the petitioner is completely innocent, Ld. advocate has prayed for relief under section 482 of BNSS.

Ld. PP, Birbhum has raised objection by referring to the materials in the CD highlighting the fact that 93 pieces tarpaulins which are of Government disaster fund have been recovered from a godown which belonged to the petitioner. At this stage, it will not be proper to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, it has been submitted.

Both sides have been heard.

Perused the C.D. and also the T.C.R.

The allegations are under sections 316/318/314/61 of BNS and the FIR has been lodged by the B.D.O, Sainthia Block. Already a huge number of Government property have been recovered and investigation is underway. At this stage, this Court is not inclined to allow the prayer for anticipatory bail and hence, the same is **rejected**.

Let a copy of this order along with the T.C.R. of G.R case no. 977 of 2026 be sent to the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Suri, Birbhum for information and taking necessary action.

The Cr. Misc. Case is disposed of.
