The application u/s 482 of BNSS is moved by the Ld. Advocate praying for anticipatory bail of the petitioners, namely, (1) Babar Ali, (2) Sekh Pyar and (3) Sekh Sirajul in connection with Illambazar P.S. Case No.130 of 2026 dated 17.05.2026 u/s 448/ 379/ 427/ 325/ 316/ 34 of IPC, giving rise to G.R. Case No.572 of 2026 of the Court of Ld. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bolpur, Birbhum.

An affidavit has been filed by Babar Ali, one of the petitioners of this case stating that no such bail application under section 482 of BNSS has been filed, nor any application is rejected by any higher forum.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case and if the petitioners are released on bail they will not abscond and will co-operate with the investigation. Ld. Lawyer for the petitioners further submits that no incident ever took place to bring the offence under the purview of sections so mentioned in the CD. On above plea, Ld. Advocate for the petitioners prays for admission of the petitioners on anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions as the Court thinks fit and proper.

Ld. PP-in-charge, Birbhum has raised objection and furnished the CD for my perusal.

I have heard both sides.

Perused the C.D and also the T.C.R.

The defacto complainant lodged the complaint to the effect that after declaration of result of the general election of 2021, on 03.05.2021 out of previous grudge the accused persons along with other associates entered into his house and ransacked his house and shop and physically assaulted his pregnant daughter-in-law causing her miscarriage.

At time of perusal of the CD, it appears that there is some medical document relating to the abortion of one Aparna Garai. Considering all aspects, a clear medical report of Aparna Garai is required to consider the bail application. The hearing of this case is put on hold till the next date fixed.

The IO is directed to collect all injury reports regarding the previous injury of Aparna Ghosh to ascertain whether the abortion was caused due to physical assault or not.
