The application u/s 483 of BNSS is moved by the Ld. advocate praying for bail of the petitioner, namely, Sadek Mondal @ Sk Sadek in connection with Dubrajpur P.S. Case No.148 of 2026 dated 05/05/2026 u/ss 126(2)/ 115(2)/ 117(2)/ 118(2)/ 3(5) of BNS, giving rise to G.R. Case No.280 of 2026 of the Court of Ld. Judicial Magistrate, Dubrajpur, Birbhum.

An affidavit has been filed by Sk Noor Islam, Tadbirkarak of this case stating that no such bail application under section 483 of BNSS has been filed, nor any application is rejected by any higher forum.

Ld. advocate has prayed for bail for the sole accused on the ground of long detention, submitting that there would be no necessity for any further detention of the accused. It is submitted that the accused will not run away and shall cooperate with the IO.

Ld. PP, Birbhum has raised objection by referring to the gravity of the injuries inflicted upon the victim.

The complainant has also appeared on record and raised objection against the bail prayer.

All sides have been heard.

Perused the C.D and also the T.C.R.

It is true that the accused is in custody for quite some time but it is also true that the victim has been brutally assaulted and there is enough material in the CD. At this stage, this Court is of the view that granting liberty to the petitioner will not be in the interest of investigation. Hence, after careful scrutiny of the materials in the CD, bail prayer is **rejected** at this stage.

Let a copy of this order along with T.C.R. of G.R. 280 of 2026 be sent to the Ld. Judicial Magistrate, Dubrajpur, Birbhum.

CD be returned.

The Cr. Misc. Case is disposed of.
