The application u/s 482 of BNSS is moved by the Ld. Advocate praying for anticipatory bail of the petitioners, namely, (1) Jayanta Dhibar and (2) Wasim Raja Siddique @ Mithun in connection with Suri P.S. Case No.393 of 2026 dated 03.07.2026 u/s 147/148/149/171(F)/448/323/325/379/506 of IPC and Section 9(b)(ii) of I.E. Act and Section 25/27 of Arms Act, giving rise to G.R. Case No.1099 of 2026 of the Court of Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Suri, Birbhum.

An affidavit has been filed by Jayanta Dhibar, one of the petitioners of this case stating that no such bail application under section 482 of BNSS has been filed, nor any application is rejected by any higher forum.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case and if the petitioners are released on bail, they will not abscond and will cooperate with the process of law. Ld. Lawyer for the petitioners further submits that the alleged sections are inserted in the FIR is an abuse of process of law. On above plea, Ld. Advocate for the petitioners prays for admission of the petitioners on anticipatory bail on any terms and conditions as the Court thinks fit and proper.

Ld. PP-in-charge, Birbhum has raised objection and furnished the CD for perusal.

I have heard both sides.

Perused the C.D and also the T.C.R.

The defacto complainant lodged the complaint to the effect that he is the worker of rival political party and in the year 2022 he filed a nomination for Suri Municipal Election and on 09.02.2022 at 09:00 P.M the accused being accompanied with other miscreants entered into his house and assaulted him along with his family members and pressured him to withdraw the nomination and committed to theft of Rs.70,000/- along with gold ornaments and threatened them with dire consequences and compelled him to withdraw his nomination. CD does not reveal any injury report. There is no seized list in the record. It is observed from the record that the incident took place long ago. Considering the materials on CD including statements u/s. 180 of BNSS and other materials on record, custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

Hence, it is,

Ordered

that in the event of arrest, petitioners, namely, (1) Jayanta Dhibar and (2) Wasim Raja Siddique @ Mithun, may be released on bail of Rs.5,000/- each with two sureties of

Rs.2500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer of this case on condition that the petitioners shall abide by the provision as laid down in section 482(2) of BNSS.

Let a copy of this order along with the T.C.R. of G.R. Case No.1099 of 2026 be sent to the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Suri, Birbhum for information and taking necessary action.

Let another copy of this order be sent to the S.P, Birbhum for information.
