The application u/s 483 of BNSS is moved by the Ld. Advocate praying for bail of the petitioner, namely, Astik Pal @ Astick Pal in connection with Suri P.S. Case No.282 of 2026 dated 23/05/2026 u/ss 69/77 of BNS, giving rise to G.R. Case No.813 of 2026 of the Court of Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Suri, Birbhum.

An affidavit has been filed by Tarun Kumar Pal, Tadbirkarak of this case stating that no such bail application under section 483 of BNSS has been filed, nor any application is rejected by any higher forum.

Ld. advocate for the petitioner has submitted that admittedly there was a relationship between victim and the accused and the relationship was purely consensual. It is submitted that the victim is a married woman and therefore, the allegation of promise to marry does not sustain at all. Highlighting the difference between the two, the Ld. advocate has argued that the relationship between two consenting persons never constitute an offence under section 69 of BNS. It is contended that the accused is in custody since long, it is prayed that the accused may be released on bail at this stage.

Ld. public prosecutor, Birbhum has raised vehement objection by submitting that admission of relationship itself shows that the allegations are not false and therefore, at this stage of investigation it will not be proper to allow the prayer for bail.

Having heard both sides and having scrutinized the materials on record, it is clear that the accused and the victim had physical relationship. Even they lived together at a rented accommodation. It is found that the allegations are not totally false and in view of the offence under section 69 of BNS and the stage of investigation, granting bail at this stage is not in the interest of a proper investigation and therefore, the prayer is considered and **rejected**.
