Order No. 06 dated 07.09.2026

The application u/s 482 of BNSS is moved by the Ld. Advocate praying for anticipatory bail of the petitioners, namely, (1) Biki Ghosh and (2) Alimuddin Mondal @ Alimuddin Sk in connection with Murarai P.S. Case No.185 of 2026 dated 23.06.2026 u/s 117(2)/ 118(2)/ 329(4)/ 74/ 351(2)/ 3(5) of BNS, giving rise to G.R. Case No.1638 of 2026 of the Court of Ld. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rampurhat, Birbhum.

An affidavit has been filed by Biki Ghosh, one of the petitioners of this case stating that no such bail application under section 482 of BNSS has been filed, nor any application is rejected by any higher forum.

The Ld. Advocate for the petitioners has submitted that as per the petition of complaint the origin of dispute is relating to landed property and due to previous grudge the alleged attack took place. It is also submitted that in the selfsame incident the petitioner no.02 also got injured. One photocopy of emergency ticket is filed in support the submission. On perusal of the photocopy, it is found that the name of assailant is Sajahan Ali and Sahabuddin Sk. Sajahan Ali happens to be the husband of the informant. Ld. advocate for the accused persons prayed for anticipatory bail on any condition.

Ld. Public Prosecutor, Birbhum submitted the CD and referred the materials on CD and registered his objection against the bail prayer. It is submitted that during investigation sufficient incriminating material is collected against the present petitioners. He also referred the documents relating to treatment of the alleged victims.

Both sides have been heard.

Perused the C.D and also the T.C.R.

On perusal of the CD, I find that the injury reports do not prima facie substantiate the offence punishable under section 118(2) of BNS. In the nature of the alleged offence, custodial interrogation may not be necessary for effective investigation. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

Hence, it is,

Ordered

that in the event of arrest, petitioners, namely, (1) Biki Ghosh and (2) Alimuddin Mondal @ Alimuddin Sk, may be released on bail of Rs.3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs.1500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer of this case on condition that the petitioners shall abide by the provision as laid down in section 482(2) of BNSS.
