Claimant and the insurance company agree to resolve the dispute amicably between themselves on the following terms and conditions :-

1) The compensation amount is settled at **Rs. 4,70,000/-** towards full and final claim in this case.

2) Insurance company shall pay the settled amount of **Rs. 4,70,000 /-** towards full and final settlement of the claim by issuing three equal account payee cheques in the name of claimants namely, **1. Mina Bibi, 2. Usuf Khan and 3) Kutubuddin Khan** within one month from this date failing which awarded amount shall carry an interest @6% till payment and the claimants are at liberty to get the award executed according to law.

Accordingly, the instant case be and the same is settled on the basis of the terms of settlement as mentioned above.

Let the court fees, if paid, be refunded.

Let copy of this order be supplied to the parties free of cost.

Thus this MAC case is disposed of.
