: OPERATIVE ORDER :

1. Application is allowed.
2. The applicant Sarvari Begum Ansari be released on bail in connection with C.R. No.03/2023, registered with NCB, Mumbai U/Secs. 20(b)(ii)(C) read with Section 8(c), and section 27(A), 28, 8A(b), 27B, 29 of NDPS Act, on her furnishing personal bond of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rs. One Lakh Only) with surety in the like amount, on following conditions.
 - a) Applicant shall attend concerned office of NCB on first and third Saturday of every month between 11.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. If the first and third Saturdays of the said month fall on a holiday and/or non Court working day, the applicant shall mark presence on the next working day.
 - b) Applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any persons acquainted with fact of the case.
 - c) Applicant shall not indulge into similar activities and repeat the offence while on bail.
 - d) Investigating officer to initiate action on any breach of conditions committed by applicant.
 - e) Applicant shall furnish documents regarding her present residential address alongwith details and documents of her two close relatives and native place, address before the court at the time of furnishing PR bond and to submit the same to I.O.

- f) Applicant shall surrender her passport, if any, with the investigating officer of the concerned police station.
- g) Applicant shall not leave the territorial jurisdiction of this court without permission of this court.
- h) Applicant shall attend the Court regularly.
