Record is put up by petition.

Respondents / award holders have prayed for placing the record by way of moving a put up petition so that directions given by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on 15.06.2026 can be complied with duly. Copy of the put up petition has been served upon the petitioners / award debtors. The put up petition is considered and allowed. The record is placed.

The respondents / award holders have filed an application under section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure for implementation and giving effect to the directions passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and the said application is perused.

Ld. Advocates on both sides are present. The Ld. Advocates have been heard.

It has been stated that the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in connection with the present case passed an order on 15.06.2026 in which the Hon'ble Court was pleased to direct that *"the Reference Court is directed to release of 25% of the deposited amount in favour of the original respondents, including Narendra Kumar Anchalia, within one week. This release shall be subject to his furnishing an undertaking on affidavit that after the adjudication of the apportionment / title suit, the excess amount, if any, shall be refunded along with interest, as may be determined by the Court. Such undertaking shall be furnished before the Reference Court"*.

It has been further directed that the balance amount is to be kept in a fixed deposit in a nationalized bank, and it has been further directed that the reference Court would decide the inter say apportionment / title dispute between the parties expeditiously.

The said order dated 15.06.2026 has been gone through.

It appears that the application dated 23.06.2026 filed by the respondents should be heard on a priority basis after giving an opportunity to the petitioners to put in objection, if any, and as such let 30.06.2026 be fixed for next hearing. Written objection, if any, by the petitioners / award debtors in the meantime.

To **30.06.2026** for hearing of the application dated 23.06.2026 and for passing further order, W/O, if any, in the meantime.
