The original respondents prayed for disbursement of 25% of the deposited amount on the ground that the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has been pleased to issue certain directions upon the Reference Court and in pursuance to the said order dated 15.06.2026 of the Hon'ble Court it has been prayed that an order for release of the amount needs to be passed.

The Id counsel appearing for the State of West Bengal has submitted that the Award passed by the sole arbitrator has been challenged and the State will suffer irreparable loss if the amount deposited by the State is disbursed before disposal of the Misc. Case under section 34 of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996.

The applicants Sunil Anchalia and others (who have filed a petition under Order 1 Rule 10(2) CPC) prayed for adjournment on the ground that the counsel, who ordinarily resides in Delhi, has not arrived and having heard all sides the said prayer is allowed. However, it is mentioned that on the next date fixed i.e. 04.07.2026 all the parties are directed to appear as hearing of the petition dated 23.06.2026 will be taken up positively.
