Today is fixed for hearing of petition dated 14.07.2026 along with two petitions under Order 1 Rule 10(2) of CPC and also petition dated 16.07.2026.

Ld. Advocate of both parties are present.

Ld. G.P. is also present.

Ld. Advocate for the O.P. namely Sunil Anchalia files one online copy of order passed by the Hon'ble High Court in CO-2268 of 2026 dated 14.07.2026 wherein Hon'ble Court has been pleased to pass order viz “ **CO 2268 of 2026 stands disposed of by requesting the learned District Judge, Birbhum to decide the inter se apportionment/title dispute strictly in terms of the directions passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the order dated June 15,2026.**

It is , however , made clear that this Court has not interfered with the directions passed by the Reference Court upon the Head Accountant, District Judge's Court, Suri, Birbhum to disburse the amount to the original respondents as indicated in the order impugned.

Before parting it is made clear that this Court has not entered into the claims and counter-claims between the respective parties insofar as the dispute regarding apportionment/ title dispute is concerned and all points are left open to be decide by the learned District Judge, if the same is raised in the miscellaneous case.”Let the copy of order be kept with the record.

Ld. Advocate for the respondent namely, Narendra Kumar Anchalia files a letter dated 17.07.2026 addressed to the Head Accountant, District Judge's Court, Birbhum. Let the same be kept with the record.

The pending petitions are taken up for hearing.

Heard both sides in part.

At the time of hearing Ld. Advocate appearing on behalf of the State raised strong objection in respect of payment order filed on 16.07.2026.
