Sentence or order

: Accused is convicted for the offence punishable
u/S.118(a) of Kerala Police Act and he is sentenced to pay a fine of ₹1000 for the same. In default
of payment of fine, the accused shall undergo Simple Imprisonment for 1 day.

This case having been finally heard on this day, the court passed the following:

JUDGMENT

1. The accused stands trial for the offence punishable u/S.118(a) of Kerala Police Act.
2. The prosecution case is, in brief as follows:- The accused was found drunk, incapable of taking of care of himself and behaved in a disorderly manner under influence of alcohol at the public place. Thus the accused committed offence punishable u/S.118(a) of Kerala Police Act.
3. Accused appeared before court, copies of all prosecution records were furnished, a charge was framed against accused for the alleged offense u/S.118(a) of Kerala Police Act and read over and explained to the accused in Malayalam to which he pleaded guilty. He was warned of the consequences of pleading guilty, even then he pleaded guilt. The plea being voluntarily made, by the accused the same stands accepted, and the accused is found guilty and convicted u/S.118(a) of Kerala Police Act. Accused also pleaded leniency of sentence. Considering the facts and circumstance I fined that imposing of fine is adequate.
4. In the result,

1. The accused is convicted u/S.241 of Cr.P.C. for the offence punishable u/S.118(a) of Kerala Police Act and he is sentenced to pay a fine of ₹1000/- for the same. In default of payment of fine, the accused shall undergo Simple Imprisonment for 1 day.
