This is an application under Section 483 BNSS filed by or on behalf of petitioner namely; **Goutam Let** in connection with Rampurhat PS cae no. 314/2025 dated 18-06-2025 under Sections 115(2)/117(2)/109/3(5) of BNS corresponding to G.R.Case No. 1485 of 2025.

Heard the learned Counsel for the petitioner and the learned P. P-in-charge.

Learned Lawyer for the petitioner submits that charge-sheet has already been filed and accused person is innocent. Thus, he may be granted bail under any terms and conditions.

On the contrary, the Ld. Counsel for the prosecution opposes the prayer for bail on the ground that there are materials against this accused person and for that custody trial is needed.

Having heard both sides and on perusal of C.D and case record, it transpires that CS has been submitted in this case inter alia u/s 109(1) BNS. However, considering facts and circumstances of this case, I think custodial trial is not essential and thus there is no point to reject bail application of the present accused person. Further, if he is enlarged on bail, the prosecution will not be affected in any manner. Therefore, bail prayer stands allowed.

Accused person/applicant may find bail of Rs. 2000/- with one surety of like amount, subject to satisfaction of Ld. ACJM, Rampurhat with condition to attend the court on every date of hearing and not to threat the witnesses of this case in any manner, i.d his bail order may be cancelled.

The Criminal Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
