This is an application under Section 483 BNSS filed by or on behalf of petitioner namely; **Lalu Let @ Sunil Let** in connection with Nalhati PS Case No. 07 of 2026 dated 05-01-2026 under Sections 85/118(2)/109(1)/103(1) of BNSS corresponding to G.R.Case No. 30 of 2026.

Heard the learned Counsel for the petitioner and the learned P.P-in-charge.

Learned Lawyer for the petitioner submits that accused person is in custody for a considerable period and there is no chance of his absconding. It is further submitted that he is a senior citizen and was not involved in the alleged offences of this case. Thus he may be enlarged on bail on any terms and condition.

On the contrary, the Ld. Counsel for the prosecution opposes the prayer for bail on the ground that investigation is still going on and this accused person was actively involved in commission of offences. Therefore, if accused is enlarged on bail he may tamper with the evidence and flee away.

Having heard both sides and on perusal of C.D and case record, it transpires that investigation is in full force and gravity of offence is serious in nature. Considering present facts and circumstances of this case and for the interest of investigation, I feel not inclined to allow bail prayer.

Hence, bail prayer stands rejected.

The Criminal Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
