This is an application under Section 483 BNSS filed by or on behalf of petitioner namely; **Nur Mohammad** in connection with Nalhati PS Case No. 30 of 2026 dated 17-01-2026 under Sections 126(2)/117(2)/109(1)/adding 103/3(5) of BNS corresponding to G.R. Case No. 146 of 2026.

Some documents have been filed on behalf of accused persons as per firisti. Let the same be kept with the record.

Heard the learned Counsel for the petitioners and the learned P.P-in-charge.

Learned Lawyer for the petitioner submits that accused person is in custody for a considerable period. Further he has been falsely implicated in this case and on the alleged date of incident he himself sustained injury. There is no chance of his absconding and as such he may be enlarged on bail on any terms and conditions.

On the contrary, the Ld. Counsel for the prosecution opposes the prayer for bail on the ground that investigation is still going on and if accused is enlarged on bail he may tamper with the evidence.

Having heard both sides and on perusal of C.D and case record including documents submitted by accused person, it transpires that investigation is in full force and gravity of offence is serious in nature. Considering present facts and circumstances of this case and for the interest of investigation I feel not inclined to allow bail prayer.

Hence, bail prayer stands rejected.

The Criminal Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
