Today is fixed for appearance.

4 (Four) accused persons namely, Arindam Saha, Pritam Sardar, Habib Ali and Abhijit Das are present before this Court.

Learned Advocate on behalf of the accused person is present before this Court and filed a petition praying for pleading guilty.

The Learned APP endorsed 'no objection' on the petition.

Perused the petition and heard the respective submissions of both sides.

The substance of accusation to the following effect -

“You, on 06.02.2022 despite knowing the rules and regulation of the Government were moving without wearing mask and disobeying the Government order vide No.715/Home(Cons)/RIM(Cons)-92/2021, thereby committing offences under sections 188/269/270 IPC and 51(b) of Disaster Management Act, 2005”.

is explained and read over to the accused persons in Bengali to which they pleaded guilty by saying '**Amra Doshi**'.

Hence, the accused are convicted u/s 252 of Cr.P.C. The accused are explained the punishment for offence.

Heard the convict regarding the punishment of the offence to which they pleaded mercy.

It appears that the accused here in are a first-time convict. I am inclined to take a lenient view of the punishment and sentence him to pay fine.

Hence, it is

ORDERED

That the accused person namely, Arindam Saha, Pritam Sardar, Habib Ali and Abhijit Das are found guilty of the offence punishable u/s sections 188/269/270 IPC and 51 (b) of Disaster Management Act, 2005 and is to pay fine of Rs. 500/- each i.d the convict shall suffer S.I for 05 (Five) days subject to the period already undergone by him.
