Claimants file one petition for taking off the hearing of this case from PH board along with an application under Order 6 Rule 17 CPC. As per prayer of claimants hearing of this case is taken off from PH board.

Now as per prayer of both parties, the amendment petition is taken up for hearing.

Heard both parties.

Perused the petition.

It appears that if the proposed amendment is allowed, the nature and character of the case will not be changed. This tribunal is of further opinion that for proper adjudication of this case, the instant amendment application should be allowed. Be it noted that the contesting OP put no material objection against this application. Thus, for the interest of justice, I feel inclined to allow the petition.

Hence, it is

ORDERED

that the petition under Order 6 Rule 17 with 151 CPC filed by claimants on 02-06-2026 is allowed on contest against OP no.1 and ex parte against OP no.2 without any order as to costs.

OP no.1 is given at liberty to file additional WO, if any.

Petitioners are directed to furnish amended claim petition and to serve notice upon OP no.2 afresh due to amendment of claim application.

Claimants file amended copy of claim application accordingly. Copy served.

To 15-07-2026 for filing additional WO by OP no.1 and SR of OP no.2.
