Offence : Punishable under section 279, 337 and 338 IPC.
Plea : Guilty
Finding : Guilty
Sentence/Order : Accused is convicted and sentenced to pay fine of
Rs.1000/- each for the offence punishable u/s. 279 and
338 of IPC and sentenced to pay fine of Rs.500/- for
the offence punishable u/s. 337 of IPC. In default of
payment of fine accused shall undergo simple
imprisonment for 25 days.

This case having been finally heard on today, and this Court delivered the following:-

JUDGMENT

1. The accused stands charge sheeted by the Sub Inspector of Police, Thoppumpady Police Station alleging offence punishable under section 279, 337 and 338 IPC.
2. Accused pleaded guilty. Particulars of offences u/ss..279, 337 and 338 IPC, read over and explained to the accused and he pleaded guilty. The plea of guilty is accepted and accused is found guilty of offences u/ss..279, 337 and 338 IPC and convicted thereunder.
3. The benevolent provisions of the Probation of Offenders Act is not invoked in favour of the accused since this does not appear to be a fit case to invoke the provisions of that Act.
4. As the accused had pleaded guilty a lenient view is adopted in the manner of imposing sentence.
5. Hence, accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.1000/- each for the offence punishable u/s. 279 and 338 of IPC and sentenced to pay fine of Rs.500/- for the offence punishable u/s.337 of IPC. In default of payment of fine accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 25 days.
