Sole accused person namely Choton Mal is produced from J/C. He is taken into custody and remanded to further J/C till date.

Ld. Panel P.P and Ld. Defence Counsel are present.

The case is taken up for further evidence.

Received service return of the two witness namely Sankari Mal and Dipen Mal after due service.

Ld. Panel P.P produce two witnesses namely Dipen Mal and Sankari Mal are examined in chief as well as cross examined in full and discharged as P.W-06 and P.W-07

During examination of P.W-06 proved his signature on the statement u/s-164 Cr.P.C is marked as Exbt.-2 and 2/1.

No other witness is present.

At this stage Ld. Panel PP files another petition u/s-80 of Indian evidence Act for admission of the statement u/s-164 Cr.P.C of the both witnesses namely Dipen Mal and Sankari Mal. Defense does not raised objection. As such Petition is considered and allowed.

Let the statement u/s-164 Cr.P.C of the witness namely Dipen Mal is marked as Exbt.-2/2, (On admission) and another statement u/s-164 Cr.P.C. of the witness namely Sankari Mal is marked as Exbt.-3 (On admission).

Bail petition is filed by the Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused namely Choton Mal. Let it be kept with the record.

Considering the nature and gravity of offense, Prayer for bail is rejected.

The case is adjourned today for the ends of justice.

Ld. Panel P.P in charge is directed to take steps for securing attendance of witness on the date fixed.
