Today is fixed for evidence.

All accused persons (04) on C.B. are present by filing hazira.

Ld. State counsel files hazira.

CSW-17 appears and he is examined as PW-13, cross-examined in full and discharged.

Some documents are marked as Exbt.P.6/P.W-13 to Exbt.P.8/1/P.W-13, Exbt.P.2/2/P.W-13 and Exb.P.1/2/P.W-13.

At this stage Ld. State counsel files petition praying for marking PM examination report as Exbt. in view of Section 294 of Cr.P.C.

Ld. Defence counsel put no objection against such prayer of prosecution.

It appears that genuineness of aforesaid document is not disputed by defence side. Therefore, there is no bar to admit the said document without proof of the signature of the person by whom it purports to be signed. Record reveals that evidence of other witnesses is already completed. At this stage as defence side did not dispute the said document, I feel inclined to mark the said document as Exbt. as per provision of Section 294 of C.P.C. Accordingly PM examination report dated 09-09-2022 be marked as Exbt.P.9. Thus evidence of prosecution is closed.
