Today is fixed for reconciliation and order. Both the parties and their respective Ld. Advocates are present. Heard both the petitioners and tried to reconcile the dispute. The attempt to reconcile fails.

The instant suit u/s 13B of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 is placed before me for consideration.

Both the parties are examined in full.

During examination of P.W-2, one certificate issued by Rakhi Mondal, Pradhan of Dheka Gram Panchayat on 30-07-2025 is produced and it is marked as Exbt.1.

It appears that the marriage between the parties was solemnized on 18-04-2024 according to Hindu rites and customs and after marriage they lived together as husband and wife. However, due to mal-adjustment and difference of opinion they started living separately on and from 17-06-2024. The instant case was filed on 02-08-2025. Since then six months have elapsed. During reconciliation both parties have stated that it is not possible for them to stay together. Upon going through the affidavit in-chief filed by the parties, I hardly find any scope to reunite the parties nor there appears any likelihood that they would be happily continuing their nuptial knot. They appear to have deposed voluntarily and not under duress, coercion, misrepresentation or undue influence. Under such compelling circumstances, the prayer for divorce on mutual consent is expedient to be allowed.

Accordingly the petition succeeds.

C/F paid is sufficient.

Hence, it is

**ORDERED**

that the petition u/s 13 B of the Hindu Marriage Act be and the same is allowed on consent of both parties. The marital tie between the parties as was solemnized on 18-04-2024, is hereby dissolved by a decree of divorce on mutual consent.
