Plea : Guilty

Finding : Guilty

Sentence or Order : Accused is convicted and sentenced to pay a fine of ₹500/- for offence under section 279 of IPC and simple imprisonment till the rising of court for offences under section 185 of MV Act. In default of payment of fine, the accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 15 days.

This case coming on for today's proceedings, the court delivered the following :

JUDGMENT

1. The accused in this case stands charged by the Sub Inspector of Police, Kannikode Police Station alleging commission of an offence punishable under section 279 IPC and sec. 185 of MV Act.
2. The accused present. Copies of all relevant prosecution records are furnished to him. Particulars of offences read over and explained to the accused and he pleaded guilty. Accused is found guilty of offence punishable under section 279 IPC and sec. 185 of MV Act and convicted him thereunder.
3. Considering the nature of the offence, I am of opinion that this is not a fit case to apply the benevolent provisions of Probation of Offenders Act. I am of the opinion that a sentence for fine and simple imprisonment till the rising of court will meet the ends of Justice.

In the result, the accused is sentenced to pay a fine of ₹500/- for offence under section 279 of IPC and simple imprisonment till the rising of court for offence under section 185 of MV Act. In default of payment of fine, the accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 15 days.
