The record is put up today by a put up petition.

Accused persons are present by filing hazira.

Ld. APP is present.

Perused the case record and the documents therein and prima facie found that there is sufficient material against the accused persons to frame charge U/S 341/325/506/3434 of IPC.

Accordingly charge is framed in the aforesaid section in a separate prescribed form and the contents of the same is read over and explained to the accused persons in Bengali to which they pleaded not guilty and claimed to be tried.

Witnesses namely Madan Let, Jiban Let, Prasenjit Let, Premi Let, Chintu Let, Archana Let and Lakhi Let are present before this Court by filing wakalatnama.

They are examined, cross-examined in full as PW1, PW2, PW 3, PW 4, PW 5, PW 6 and PW 7 and discharged. Evidence is closed as per the verbal prayer of the Ld. APP.

To-date for 313 of Cr.PC, DW, Argument and judgment.

Now, the record is taken up for examination of the accused persons u/Sec. 313 of Cr.PC, D.W. (if any), Argument and Judgment.

Accused persons are present by filing hazira and examined u/s. 313 of Cr.PC.

Perused the same.

No DW is adduced.

Argument will be heard at afternoon at 02:00 PM

Later: 2:00 PM

Heard argument on both sides.

Later: 4:30 PM

Judgment is ready and printed and pronounced in open Court in presence of the accused.

Hence, it is

ORDERED

that the accused persons are found not guilty of the alleged offenses U/S(s) 341/325/506/34 of IPC and thus the accused persons are acquitted u/s 248 (1) Cr.P.C.

The accused persons shall remain in the same bonds and shall be released from their respective bail bonds after a period of six months as per section 437-A of the Cr.P.C.

Sureties shall be discharged from their liability accordingly.

The victim has a right to prefer appeal under the provision to Section 372 of Cr.P.C against the said judgment and if required may seek free legal assistance from the appropriate Legal Service Authority to institute and prosecute such appeal.

Let the copy of the judgment of the acquittal be forwarded to the District Magistrate and the Chairman, D.L.S.A, Birbhum for due intimation to the victim as defined under section 2(wa) of Cr.P.C.
