Today is fixed for production of accused Islam Khan and for evidence.

Accused Islam Khan is produced from J.C. He is taken into custody.

Ld. P.P. In-charge is present in court today and files hazira.

Ld. Advocate for the accused is also present in court today and files a petition praying for bail for the accused person on the grounds stated therein. Copy served upon Ld. P.P.-in-charge.

The record is first taken up for evidence in respect of this accused person.

Today Ld. P.P.-in-charge and Ld. Advocate for the accused both filed two petitions praying for adopting the examination-in-chief of all the P.W.s done earlier in favour of the prosecution and for adopting the cross-examination of all the P.W.s done earlier in this case for the defence in respect of accused Islam Khan respectively. No objections raised by either of the side in respect of the said petitions.

Heard both sides. Considered. Perused the case record.

Considering the same, the prayer of Ld. P.P.-in-charge and also the prayer of Ld. Advocate for the accused for adopting the evidence of all P.W.s as prayed for is allowed for ends of justice in respect of accused Islam Khan.

The record is now taken up for examination of accused Islam Khan u/s 313 Cr.P.C.

The accused Islam Khan is examined u/s 313 Cr.P.C. in a separate sheet and is kept along with this record.

The bail petition filed by Ld. Advocate for the accused is taken up for consideration.

Ld. Advocate for the defence submits before the court that the accused is in custody for a considerable period of time and he further submits that the accused has undertaken to remain present on each and every day before this Court henceforth and considering the same prays before the court to grant bail to the accused person on any condition as the Court may deem fit and proper by showing mercy to the accused.

Ld. P.P. in-charge raised formal objections against bail prayer as the accused failed to turn up before this court and was absconding. Ld. P.P. in-charge further submits that if bail

is granted, the accused person must be directed to remain present on each and every date, failing which bail will be cancelled.

Perused the case record. Considered.

Considering submission of P.P. in-charge and Ld. Defence Counsel, who submits that the accused person undertakes to remain present on each and every date henceforth, and considering the period of detention, I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail of the accused person.

Hence, it is

ORDERED

That the accused person namely, Islam Khan may be released on **interim bail** on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 3,000/- with two registered sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, along with condition to remain present on each and every date before this Court subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. JM, Dubrajpur, i.d to J.C.

If on bail to 02.03.26 for appearance and argument.
