Accused has not been produced from Correctional Home. Today, the case is fixed for hearing of bail-petition dated 21.02.2025, filed on behalf of the petitioner, namely Sangita Sahani, praying for her release on bail on the ground stated therein.

Another bail-petition is also filed on behalf of accused Sangita Sahani, praying for release on bail on the ground stated therein. A petition has been filed by SI Sabir Ali, Memari PS, Purba Bardhaman, praying for passing necessary order regarding detailed enquiry for confiscation of the seized money to the State and for submission of a report to that effect before this court.

Subsequently, today's bail-petition has been not pressed by the Ld. Lawyer for the petition. Hence, this bail-petition, being not pressed, stands rejected.

Now, the bail-petition dated 21.02.2025 is taken up for hearing.

Heard Ld. Defence Lawyer and Ld. PP-in-Charge. Perused the record. Considered.

Ld. Lawyer for the accused person submits that the accused person is detained in custody since 19.12.2024 and she has permanent hearth and home and there is no chance of her abscondance. He prays for bail of the accused on any condition.

Ld. PP-in-Charge vehemently opposes the prayer for bail.

It appears from the record that huge commercial quantity of Ganja has been recovered from the possession of the accused person.

There are statutory restrictions in granting of bail, relating to commercial quantity of contraband drugs as laid down in Section 37 of the NDPS Act.

Considering the above and the nature and gravity of the alleged offence, I am not inclined to enlarge the accused person on bail.

Hence, prayer for bail of the accused person is rejected.

Fix 07.03.2025 for production of the accused person, hearing of the petition dated 24.02.2025 submitted by SI Sabir Ali, Memari PS regarding confiscation of the seized money and also for IO's report.
