JUDGMENT

1. The case is taken on today's board for the purpose of Lok Adalat as per circular of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court bearing No. B(Gen)-1001/2024/1114 dated 24.06.2024. Accused is present before the Court. Particulars of the offence is read over and explained to the accused. Accused pleaded guilty voluntarily. His plea is accepted as voluntary. Accused prayed for leniency. Considering the submissions made by the accused and in view of Lok Adalat, I proceed to pass the following order:-

ORDER

- i. Accused viz. Dipesh Shankar Gurav is hereby convicted for the offence punishable under Section 8(c) r.w. 27 of N.D.P.S. Act and sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 1,500/- (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred Only) in default to undergo R.I. for 8 (Eight) days.
