

Order No. 09 Dated 28/02/2025

This day is fixed for hearing of a petition dated 22/11/2024 filed by the petitioner-wife under Order 6 rule 17 of CPC praying for certain amendments in respect of para no. 13 of the plaint and prayer portion on the ground stated therein.

Perused the petition.

Heard Ld. Advocate of petitioner-wife.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner-wife submitted that due to inadvertence and typographical mistake, the dates mentioned in the plaint/original petition as regards para no.13 has been wrongly mentioned in the original petition filed by the petitioner-wife u/s 13 of H.M.Act, 1955. Ld. Advocate further submitted that the amendment sought for is formal in nature and character of the instant case will not be changed and prayed for passing necessary order and accordingly prayed for allowing the proposed amendment.

Considering the facts and circumstances of this case and hearing the submission of Ld. Advocate, it can safely be said that if the proposed amendment is allowed, thenature and character of the instant suit will not be changed and I also find that the amendment sought for is essential for proper adjudication of this case.

In view of the above circumstances, the instant petition dated 22/11/2024 is hereby allowed for the ends of justice.

Hence, amend the original petition/plaint filed by petitioner-wife and register the same accordingly. Let the amendment petition be made part of the original plaint.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner-wife is also directed to file the amended plaint/original petition afresh as early as possible by **22/04/2025**

Amend the original petition accordingly.

Fix 22/04/2025 for filing the amended plaint afresh by the petitioner-wife.
