

Tinku Kumar Vs Satpal

Present: Complainant with counsel Sh. A.K. Singla Adv.

Complaint presented today. It be checked and registered. Complainant is present and examined as CW1. Arguments on the point of summoning of accused heard. As per the allegations of complainant against accused cheque No. 811226 dt. 04.05.2017, worth Rs. 80,000/- was issued in favour of complainant by the accused, which was dishonoured vide endorsement dt. 09.08.2017 with the remarks 'Funds Insufficient'. Complainant issued notice but accused did not pay the amount. Hence, the present complaint.

2. On filing of complaint, complainant examined himself as CW1 and produced documents i.e. Ex. C-1 to Ex. C-3 and evidence has been closed. In view of the present circumstances, it is clear that the complainant has approached the Court within time after the dishonour of cheque and after issuing notice, therefore, prima facie case is made out under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act, accused is liable to be summoned to face trial. Let, accused be summoned on filing of copies of complaint, PF, as well as list of witnesses for 18.10.2017. RC be filed.
